Aberdare Country Club has 28 twins and 18 double-bed rooms, 36 of which are in cottages. A total of 107 guests can be catered for. The bedrooms are tastefully furnished and all have attached bathrooms. The cottages have two bedrooms each with interconnecting doors and most have fireplaces.

A balcony provides superb views of Mount Kenya and Aberdares. All rooms and cottages at the Aberdare Country Club have spectacular views of the plains, the Aberdare Mountains to the west and Mount Kenya to the east.

Guests tend to only come in for lunch before being bused off to sister hotel The Ark, higher up in the Aberdare forests. Aberdare Country Club offers first class cuisine with a selection of European, Asian and Kenyan dishes. The dining room is situated in the main building along with the lounge bar. The club is a popular venue for conferences; a choice of four rooms is available.
