

Kipini Tana River Lodge Tana River Delta is located on the Tana River Delta, in Kipini, a small fishing village, where the river meets the sea, "Tana River Lodge" is a paradise for nature lovers, with its prime location overlooking a landscape where forest, river, beach, dunes and sea come together.

The Tana River is one of the most important rivers of equatorial Africa, the longest of Kenya with over 800 km.

Along the way they found asylum populations very different from each other, from from places far away, who settled near its banks due to the reassuring presence of fresh water at all seasons of the year. Among these, the Orma and Pokomo that today live in close contact in the area of the mouth. Accommodation & Room Types

The lodge consists of 7 bungalows and 2 suites.
