

Ngare Serian is set right on the banks of the Mara river in the 80,000 acre private Mara North Conservancy. With just 4 guests tents, this is an exclusive camp, providing privacy in a secluded setting. The camp is reached by a rope bridge over the river, which must be crossed one person at a time. The camp is staffed largely by local Masai, who are friendly and extremely helpful.

Accommodation

4 marquees on on hard wood decks, open sided and lit at night by hurricane lamps. They are chic restrained with comfy seating and low hand-made tables. Each tent has a private outdoor decking, a four poster bed, a shower with a view, separate bathroom and plenty of room within which to change, store personal effects and stretch off after a safari.

Dining

There is an attractive dining deck and seating area, where guests can discuss the day's events, plan for the next day and enjoy a drink before dinner. Dinner is often served in the open air under the stars, eaten by candlelight. Ngare Serian is ideal for anyone wanting to experience an authentic safari holiday away from the crowds and enjoy the warm hospitality of the Masai people.
