The house itself is beautifully sighted on a rise overlooking Tiwi Beach, taking full advantage of the breeze which blows off the Indian Ocean. Set in two and a half acres of gardens, the spacious grounds include one of the largest and oldest Baobab trees on the South Coast.

Shimba Hills Game Reserve is less than an hour's drive to the west, and Shimoni, the Kisite Marine Park, Wasini Island and Pemba Channel big game fishing are just an hour to the south.

Self-catering is made easy with fruit and vegetable stands nearby and with Tiwi's local fishing fleet just down the beach. Fishermen bring their daily catch of snapper, kingfish, calamari and octopus to the kitchen door and can also take orders for next day delivery of fresh crab, shrimp and lobster.
